As you have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, walk in Christ. Rooted and built up in Christ, and supported in the sureness [faith], you have been taught, abounding in expression of gratitude. Beware that anyone should spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of humans, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ, for in Christ dwells all the completeness of the deity bodily.

And you have been completed in Christ, which is the head of all principality and authority, in whom also you are circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, in putting aside the body of the sins [errors] of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ. Buried with him in baptism, and you are risen with [him] through the sureness of the internal action of God, who has raised him from the dead. And you, being dead in your sins and the extreme shame of your flesh, has God made alive together with Christ, having forgiven you all mistakes; Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to the public display of him (cross); [And] having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them by freedom of speech, triumphing over them in it.

Let no person therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath, which are a shadow of things to come; but the body [is] of Christ. Let no person deceive or mislead you of your reward, insisting on self-abasement and worshipping of angels, intruding into those things which that person has not seen, vainly puffed up by their fleshly mind, and not holding the Head, from which all the body by joints and bands having nourishment ministered, and knit together, grows with the growth of God.
